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

### BRIGHT AND BLUE-TIFUL

This 35-year-old dark, boring, builder-grade kitchen was dated, falling apart, and closed off from the rest of the home. This family loves to cook and entertain and wanted an open kitchen with a lot of countertops, smart storage, and seating for at least 8 people. They were looking for a space that matched their fun, artistic personalities without being too bold for resale.

To achieve these goals, we took down

the wall between the kitchen and the previously unused dining room. This made room for banquet seating for 8+ and an open kitchen perfect for a party.

The layout was reconfigured to accommodate a large 10-1/2-foot island that houses a wine fridge, trash pull out, microwave, large drawers and roll out shelves. A 13" deep pantry makes it easy to find everything and a floating shelf

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in an accent wood coordinates with their new stained table and luxury vinyl flooring.

Crystal Current cabinetry in Simply white and Nautical blue with brushed gold hardware adds a fun pop of color and the Cambria Portrush quartz countertops feature blue veins and gold flecks that tie the color story together.

A bump out into the kitchen, which houses the powder room on the backside, gave us a unique opportunity to add faux brick tile giving a nice textural element to the space.

We ended up with a kitchen that is funky in all the right ways and perfect for this young, modern family.

Having a dressing room is a luxury that we all wish baskets under each sink. Faceted mirrors, graceful we could have. Along with a make-up area, there are new cabinets that provide storage for jewelry and accessories. Marble countertops, a crystal chandelier and mirrors in a metallic finish bring luxury and style to this space.

Moving through the elegant Dressing Room, you enter the luxurious Master Bathroom. Inset cabinets, luxe plumbing fixtures and marble tiles create a lavish space to bathe and get ready in each day. We opened up the shower, removing the soffit and dark cabinet and added glass, letting light in. Now the entire room is bright and airy with faux marble porcelain tile throughout. An archway was added to frame in the undermount tub. The double vanity in a soft gray paint and topped with Corian Quartz compliments the marble tile. The new chandelier along with the chrome fixtures add just the right amount of luxury to the room. When you come in from the bedroom you are enticed to stay a while in this beautiful space.
